

Prep Girls Basketball Playoffs: Knights make school history

The Knights are headed to the semifinals for the first time in school history after defeating the California School for the Deaf 50-42 in the CIF-Southern Section Division 5A playoffs on Wednesday night.

This is the first time that an AAE team has ever advanced past the quarterfinals in any sport. AAE will host Mesa Grande Academy in the semifinals on Saturday.

"It feels great," Knights coach Ashley Simpson said. "The cool thing is, I think that it's any coach's dream to have a team that works together, that you're proud of every win and how they've grown."

Carolina Phillips scored a game-high 17 points to lead the Knights (19-5) and Melissa Owuor scored 15.

"It came down to slowing it down, taking our time and waiting for that perfect shot," Simpson said. "We've been focusing in practice on playing smart, slowing it down if we're ahead and using the clock. They used the clock to their advantage tonight."
